Upon our request, Nash Community College security and administrators moved Planned Parenthood women (clad in pink and purple) away from blocking our abortion photo signs.

Towards the end of the September 21, 2017 display conducted by Bill & Jeanette Schultz, CBR Project Directors- Carolinas, they offered literature to a male faculty member who was passing by. He angrily responded that he would never take any of our literature and as he walked off he turned and yelled, "What you are doing is not Christian, and not something Jesus would do!" Mr. Schultz asked him, "Is it not an act of mercy to save an unborn baby's life?" The professor marched off without further reply. Thankfully, most students were receptive to our message.

This Irish CBR display took place outside the Dublin Courthouse on August 27, 2017. Following police harassment of our staff during another sign display, we received a key victory on February 4, 2018; ICBR was informed by An Garda Síochána (police) that the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions has declined to charge or prosecute the public display of abortion photo signs. The decision followed the submission of legal memoranda arguing that these public displays violated neither the Public Order Act or any other prohibition imposed by law. ICBR is gratified to learn that our position has been definitively vindicated and expressive rights will remain fully protected by the Irish Constitution.
