



# CBR Signs Expose Planned Parenthood's Eugenics Legacy



From our inception, CBR has been a strategic planning organization, consistently providing pro-lifers with strategies and resources to help stop abortion. To this day we are developing new tools, including creating new signs to expose the horror of abortion. Some of our signs take advantage of current events, such as our All Black Lives Matter signs. Many of our signs draw lessons from history and historical people.

Our newest signs educate the public about Planned Parenthood's founder Margaret Sanger. Under the leadership of CBR Board member Reverend Clenard Childress, Jr., in the week leading up to the Washington, D.C., March for Life, CBR inaugurated a new educational sign set which exposes the eugenics connection between Margaret Sanger and Adolf Hitler. Eugenics is the racially motivated practice of keeping disfavored minorities from reproducing.

Sanger wrote openly about eugenics in her 1938 book *An Autobiography: Margaret Sanger*: "I accepted one branch of this philosophy, but eugenics without birth control seemed to me a house built upon sands ... The eugenicists [sic] wanted to shift the birth control emphasis from less children for the poor to more children for the rich. We went back of that and sought *first* [emphasis ours] to stop the multiplication of the unfit. This appeared the most important and greatest step towards race

betterment." [https://en.wikiquote.org/wiki/Margaret\\_Sanger](https://en.wikiquote.org/wiki/Margaret_Sanger) Ms. Sanger used the language of eugenicists to refer to people she deemed unworthy of life, just as abortionists apply demeaning language to preborn children: "Birth control ... means the release and cultivation of the better racial elements in our society, and the gradual suppression, elimination and eventual extirpation of defective stocks—those human weeds which threaten the blooming of the finest flowers of American civilization" ("Apostle of Birth Control Sees Cause Gaining Here," *The New York Times*, 1923-04-08, p. XII).

Interestingly, Ms. Sanger spoke negatively about the right to free speech: "I care nothing for Free Speech in and by itself. All of us place too much value on the power of the printed word and the power of the spoken word" (Ford Hall Forum Boston Speech).

We deeply value the right to free speech granted us by the Constitution, and we exercise it daily on behalf of preborn children. As a recent example, during the week of the 46th Annual March for Life in Washington, D.C., we selected key locations at which to display the new signs. Included were the headquarters of several pro-abortion organizations.

# Sibling of VCU Student Forever Lost to Abortion

**S**tudents at Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) in Richmond, Virginia, were privileged to see our Genocide Awareness Project (GAP) when our team visited their campus October 1-2, 2018. Most do not realize that GAP is a powerful teaching tool that they need to see, but we are convinced that they must see the photographic evidence about abortion to counter all the lies they've been told. As our Lord Jesus said, "the truth shall make you free." (John 8:32b) God has used GAP to free millions of students to know the truth about abortion and to make good decisions as a result.

GAP can bring up strong emotions for those already affected by abortion. A pro-life student named Olivia told us that more than 20 years ago her father pressured her mother to abort her older sister. It was apparent that she bore emotional scars from the knowledge that her father in essence ordered that her sister be killed by abortion; she cried as she told us about it and made it clear that she wants to volunteer with CBR. Abortion advocates ignore young women like Olivia as they will not address the far-reaching effects of abortion on each family.

A young lady from Burundi was a survivor of the 2004 genocide in Burundi, and she subsequently came to the U.S. as a refugee. She told CBR staff member Jane Bullington that she had no problem with our genocide comparisons. What a far cry from some Jewish students who reject our genocide comparisons because they are determined to support abortion.

God sometimes sends unexpected people to help students understand the message of GAP. An older gentleman appeared and gently entered into a conversation we were having with four female students. He asked, "What is your goal here?" Mrs. Bullington felt he was like an angel as he gently steered the conversation. He kept reminding the students that there are places in every community where low-cost health services can be found – they need not go to Planned Parenthood. After about an hour, the gentleman disappeared.

Nathan and Norab were students who were very thankful we were on their campus, saying, "It is hard to hold on in this environment." Our presence often emboldens students to speak on behalf of preborn children

Mik'aela Raymond, a CBR staff member who is black, had a marathon conversation with a group of pro-abortion black students. CBR Director of Minority Outreach Jackie Hawkins came to join the discussion as she realized that these students were being vicious towards Miss Raymond. She reports: "They saw me, gasped, and exclaimed, 'Look! There are two of them!'" In the midst of their mean remarks, the pro-abortion students trotted out various sob stories to justify abortion. Miss Hawkins chimed in with her story and asked if she should

have been aborted. They said "yes," because Miss Hawkins was part of the GAP team. Their effrontery didn't fluster Miss Hawkins and she proceeded to have some fun with them as she pointed out the ridiculous things there were saying; they became incredibly frustrated that their barbs didn't penetrate. We know that some of the rudest students will go home at night and their consciences will bother them. Some even return to apologize for their ill behavior.

Some Christian students are confused both about abortion as well as the need to speak up against evil. Molly was undecided about abortion, acknowledging she hasn't done the research to know when human life begins. Staff member Joanna Keilson challenged Molly to decide what she believes and to stand up for truth. When Molly raised a concern about "being loving and earning the right to talk to someone," Miss Keilson reminded her of the prophets, the disciples and Jesus who preached against sin, calling people to repentance without "earning the right." This kind of mentality is a cop out for Christians. Scripture is more than clear that we are held accountable to "speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves." Prov. 31:8

Miss Keilson was surprised when a student came up to quietly to express her appreciation for what we are doing. The next surprise was to learn that this sweet 18-year-old female was a transgender person who identifies as a heterosexual man, and as a Christian. As they conversed, Miss Keilson asked her/him how she grapples with the Bible's teaching that God's design is a man and a woman. The student replied, "That's hard but, I identify as a heterosexual man so it is a man and a woman" This student has bought into various deceptions of the enemy and needs our prayer.

It is vital that we continue to bring GAP to universities and colleges. If we don't bring the truth to students, who will?
