Capital Campaign - Help CBR Double Our Impact

We thank God for our successful 2025 travels, bringing the prenatal science exhibit to 12 public universities, two Christian universities, four churches and a public square. We announced our Capital Campaign in the November issue. This campaign is to raise funds to purchase an identical exhibit of 20 seven-foot column signs with award-winning content, 20 A-frame signs, plus two Ford Transit trucks to transport the exhibit. With two exhibits, we can position one for displays on the East Coast and a second on the West Coast.

Our prenatal science project is vital because three out of four Americans are unable to answer even basic questions about prenatal development. More than two-thirds of

the public supports first trimester abortion because they mistakenly believe the baby is a “blob of tissue” or a “clump of cells” during the first trimester (that’s the first 90 days). This is the stage of pregnancy during which 90% of abortions occur.

Our goal of \$250,000 will enable us to purchase this second prenatal science exhibit, including the purchase and necessary modifications of two trucks. Your generosity will help us get there! Note “Exhibit” in your check memo or online gift. You will help us expand the most effective project we have ever undertaken. We must raise this capital campaign money over and above the funds we normally raise to cover our usual operating expenses.



Outdoor Education - Prenatal Science Exhibit at 14 Universities

We ended the year having conducted the Prenatal Science Exhibit at 14 universities. As we erected the 20 columns filled with photos and facts about prenatal development, we thanked God for the First Amendment which prevents public universities from blocking our displays. It is vital that we are on these campuses educating students. The final two public universities we toured this fall were: East Tennessee State University (ETSU) in Johnson City, Tennessee October 28-29, and Western Carolina University (WCU) in Cullowhee, North Carolina October 30-31.

A student at ETSU took time to stop and share two poignant testimonies. “Colin” himself was spared being aborted when his mother chose to give birth at age 19. She never regretted her decision and went on to college. Colin’s friend survived an abortion attempt when he was eight months gestation! He is alive, but he bears the scars on his back. (The Prenatal Science displays do not mention abortion, but people do raise the subject.) God obviously has plans for these young men.

An ETSU staff member read through all of the signs. When he returned to the exhibit a third time, he thanked us for being on campus. God knows what seeds we are planting.

Here is some positive feedback shared by female students at WCU:

- A criminal justice major said: “Thank you for bringing this. It contains a lot of useful information, and I didn’t know any of it. I feel like I should have known by now.”
- A student told CBR volunteer Marie: “I love your displays. They are really pretty.” We are thankful that she noticed the columns are esthetically pleasing as well as highly educational.

A young woman was spotted by CBR Project Manager Brad Martel videotaping the full length of the exhibit, twice. It seems that she not only wanted to know the maternal and prenatal information, but we trust she will share it widely.

A physical education faculty member thanked us for being



on campus and expressed amazement at how “ignorant” most students were about prenatal development. Thankfully, our exhibit removes them from the island of ignorance.

This travel season was exhausting and required massive effort, but feedback of this sort is greatly encouraging to us – and we hope to you as well.

Pakistani Baby Boy Saved!

Our CBR-Pakistan director, Muqrab, emailed us to share a photo of a precious boy whose life was saved through a CBR-Pakistan campaign early this year. My wife was delighted to read that he was born on her birthday, November 11.

His parents are in a tough financial situation, so they were not in favor of having a baby. God changed their minds during a CBR-Pakistan campaign and they chose life. “Sarah” gave birth to baby “Sam,” but he was in critical condition. God spared his life a second time, and he is now healthy. Muqrab and team are looking forward to providing basic baby gifts for this little child saved from abortion. Baby Shower Remembrance

It is a blessing to recall past CBR victories as well as 2025 victories. We have not previously published this testimony from faithful CBR staff member Jane Bullington, so we will bless you with it now.

Mrs. Bullington recounts this story, “About 12 years ago, a young lady walked up to the Genocide Awareness Project (GAP) display with a stunned look on her face. She had just found out she was pregnant and had asked God for a sign. What a sign she received! We talked and then she called her boyfriend over. He came grudgingly but listened. After saying everything I had been trained to say and not sensing much agreement, I looked at him and said, “You are a father no matter what. Do you want to be the father of a living child or the father of a dead child?” He softened. We stayed in touch; I went to the baby shower and was at the hospital shortly after delivery. For seven years, their little girl came to our home for visits and my heart was so full.” This child will be celebrating her 12th Christmas this year. Just think if we had not been on her mother’s campus.
