Kentucky Students Learn Prenatal Science

The powerful prenatal science exhibit visited two universities in April, both in Kentucky. Our commanding exhibit with 20 columns, seven-foot-high, educates the public about the various stages of prenatal development, beginning with day one and progressing through the ninth month in the womb.

The stunning photos of preborn children come from embryoscopy video footage, as well as 3-D ultrasound imaging in the later months of pregnancy. Those who stop to view the exhibit are stunned.

During the exhibit at Western Kentucky University (WKU) on April 13-14, an accounting student was grateful to see advocacy for pregnancy, particularly in a form that was not about abortion. She and her husband want to have five children. As she stayed to ask questions about seat belts, volunteer Pam offered to pray with her, which she gladly accepted.

CBR Project Manager Brad Martel watched a young male student start walking down the columns, starting with the nine-month baby down to the human embryo. He will not forget what he has seen if/when his wife or girlfriend becomes pregnant.

The CDC and the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists have alerted the public that a crisis exists in maternal-fetal health in America, and because we carefully monitor the news, we took notice. U.S. pregnancy outcomes are the worst in the Western world! Many in the medical community, and certainly the public, are unaware of this crisis. These adverse pregnancy outcomes are often preventable with education on facts related to prenatal development. Our exhibit features facts about pregnant women, educating about basic protections for mother and

child, such as avoiding harmful behaviors while pregnant – like drinking and smoking. It also focuses on healthy behaviors like wearing seat belts and healthy eating. We are helping end the crisis when we inform people about what improves pregnancy outcomes. Our exhibit increases awareness of the fact that black and Hispanic women are particularly at risk during pregnancy due to a number of factors, known and unknown.

Some webcast influencers are speaking out about the fact that abortion is also part of the crisis. During the “Actual Friends” podcast on May 16, 2026, Sage Stelle shared this reality during the discussion about President Trump’s intent to offer IVF financial assistance and “The View’s” criticism of it: “What the women of ‘The View’ and millions of other people on the left choose to ignore constantly is the mortality rate of black babies due to abortion. In New York City, I believe in 2025, in 2024 as well, there were more black babies aborted than born. Not even close.” [Editor’s note: CBR does NOT endorse IVF on the basis of morality.]

There are those who do not want to know the truth about human prenatal development, much less have it displayed on their campuses. Two young women walked past the display, and then they turned around to walk past it again. One student began to throw down seven of our A-frame signs. We called the campus police to report this vandalism, and we gave our security camera footage to campus police. They informed us they will investigate further. Pray for this student; see her photo at right.

The second campus where we erected the prenatal science exhibit was Murray State University (MSU) on April 15-16. Thousands of students saw the exhibit, and the following are a few of the people who stopped to talk with our team:

- A young father was pulling a wagon with two little children in it. He and his wife are expecting their third child, so the photos must have blessed him.
- A 50-year-old returning student agreed that maternal-fetal health information needs to be offered on campus. He was surprised that campus administrators permitted us on campus (thank God for Freedom of Speech!). He described how he saw a female take pictures of our exhibit, but then she gave us a thumbs down without even talking to one of our team members. Thankfully, she can reflect on the preborn baby photos that are now on her phone.
- A fireman and a structural engineer studied all four sides of every column. Volunteer Chad noted that they were impressed.

Volunteer Pam has served with CBR during Genocide Awareness Project campus tours, and she believes this new prenatal science approach is just as effective. She also believes when students realize we're offering them serious health information that they need to know, they'll embrace this display. Pam recognizes the columns are informative and they "introduce biology to college students who are, sadly, mostly ignorant or even misinformed on pregnancy and the development of human beings."

Pakistani Grandmother Saves Her Grandchild Thanks to CBR-Pakistan Educational Campaign

When the CBR-Pakistan team recently returned to a village for another outreach campaign, an elderly woman recognized them and said with a smile, "You came back." She had attended a CBR-Pakistan campaign several months earlier. When she learned that CBR-Pakistan was visiting the area again, she walked over a mile and a half to attend the meeting. She had something important to share.

Soon after CBR-Pakistan educated her, her daughter-in-law became pregnant with a third child. The family already had two daughters, and when doctors confirmed this baby was also a girl, relatives began urging the family to abort this baby girl. Thank the Lord, the grandmother remembered the message she had heard and the photos she had seen that prove the value of every preborn life. She intervened, telling her family, "We can't do this. Even if life is difficult, we should not take this child's life."

Her grandbaby was saved! Pray for CBR-Pakistan as they serve in a challenging country with minimal funds, but with tremendous hearts for the Lord and these families.
