"We're Going to See the Babies!"

The preschool-aged child called out, "No, we're going to see the babies!" when one of the boys asked, "Are we going to the playground?" Their teacher was leading the Sunday School class outside to see the Psalm 139 Project at Eden Chapel in Seymour, Tennessee. The teacher walked her students around the display of 20 columns containing spectacular photos of preborn babies, in addition to information related to maternal health. The 13 tiny students absorbed the photos of preborn babies, often pointing at the seven-foot columns. This was better than the playground.

Eden Chapel welcomed the Psalm 139 display to their church on August 9, 2026. Next to the 7-foot columns were 20 A-frame signs containing Scripture about the sanctity of life. The signs include passages which clarify how God is involved in creation and life in the womb, for example:

Inspiring Pregnancy Resource Center Directors

A CBR team participated in the Tennessee Pregnancy Center Network (TNPCN) conference from July 16-17, 2026. We had a prenatal science exhibit booth filled with resources for the pregnancy resource centers (PRC's), and CBR Executive Director Gregg Cunningham was given the opportunity to address nearly 30 pregnancy resource center directors in a breakout session.

This annual TNPCN conference was held at Calvary Chapel in Chattanooga, Tennessee. In his session, Mr. Cunningham stated that abortion clinics are becoming obsolete due to the abortion pill. Sadly, most PRC's are seeing fewer clients due to the same reason; with a simple phone call, women who don't want to be pregnant can arrange for abortion pills to be mailed directly to their homes. How horrific this situation is at countless levels. Even mail carriers and commercial delivery truck drivers are compelled to become part of the baby-killing business.

There is little or no supervision by the abortion doctor, and women are left to their own devices to decide when they will take the abortion pills. Many are requesting and taking mifepristone and misoprostol long after the FDA-recommended usage of up to 10 weeks' gestation, which is 8 weeks following fertilization.

An IPSOS health survey (2021) reported that three out of four Americans cannot correctly answer most of the questions they were asked about prenatal development. This is why so many fall for the lie that the human embryo and early human fetus are mere "blobs."

Two-thirds of Americans support abortion in the first trimester, when 90% of abortions take place. The pro-life movement is generally slow to change and acts like it is still 1990. Our strategies must change to keep up with the changing conditions.

Mr. Cunningham urged the directors to "get out of the PRC's and into your communities." We can assist the PRC's in sponsoring prenatal science and maternal health exhibits at their churches, schools and in their parks. Each woman who visits a PRC should download the See Baby Grow app, which will educate them about their child growing within. If people are pressuring her to abort, which is all too common, she can show (or text) them the living baby videos on her phone and tell that person: "This is why I won't abort."

Is this a blob or a baby? Exhibits filled with prenatal development photos also make the answer quite clear.

Educating people in their communities about prenatal and maternal health also helps address the maternal-fetal health crisis in America. The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reports that the U.S. has worse maternal-fetal health outcomes than some third-world countries. Additionally, the CDC reports that 70% of adverse pregnancy outcomes are preventable. The educational displays address these concerns.

A number of the directors responded with enthusiasm as they extended invitations for us to come to their communities. Partnering with the PRC's and their willingness to use CBR photos will improve their fundraising. Their supporters will be blessed to see the preborn baby videos and photos.

school, she will recognize Planned Parenthood's lies as lies.

CBR Project Manager Brad Martel listened as a child (approximately five years old) commented as he pointed at a preborn baby's umbilical cord: "There's the thing that connects to the baby and makes his belly button." It is a blessing to see how frequently children will instruct other children about what they are seeing in the prenatal development photos.

Capital Campaign

Consider helping CBR reach our Capital Campaign goal of \$250,000 to purchase a second prenatal science exhibit of 20 seven-foot column signs with award-winning content, 20 A-frame signs, plus two Ford Transit trucks to transport the exhibit. As of this writing, donors have given a total of \$42,925. The prototype of a slightly adjusted column size is currently being built. One donor has given \$1000 two months in a row, which is a big boost, yet every gift is a tremendous blessing.

Donors Tell Us Why They Support CBR

A supporter of CBR wrote to say that although he is a Roman Catholic who disdains abortion, his life circumstances are what motivates him to give to CBR. He shared his compelling story of being conceived by an unmarried couple in Nova Scotia, Canada. They were barely 18 years old and didn't want a baby. "They had no reason to really do anything except have an abortion performed to end their 'problem' of an unwanted child. I believe that through the intervention of the Holy Spirit, my life was spared - a true miracle."

These young parents chose to send their baby to an orphanage in Quebec, Canada. "I consider that one of the greatest gifts in my life and ask God to bless those two every day for their wisdom at such a young age and in such a circumstance of life." At around 5 months of age, he was adopted by parents from the United States. Interestingly, he later became a U.S. citizen in the fourth grade as a class project. His adoptive family gave him "unconditional love; they gave me all they had, upbringing, schooling, discipline, companionship, sympathy, guidance, and my faith."

After an "amazing 40-year career, working with some of the smartest and innovative people in the world for the benefit of our country," he has retired and he spends much time with his father, who is now 100 years old. He acknowledges that his parents gave him "the gift of having an opportunity to live a fulfilling and most importantly a holy life, so that I can fulfill the will of God for me in my life."

He further wrote: "All this is because an abortion was avoided, again through the wisdom of the Holy Spirit, manifest in my adoption. This is why I find CBR's mission so compelling and important. I want you to be a huge success in your outreach so more can have what I cherish." D.M.
